Shows close 7 days before show date. In order to inform you of your ride times we need your complete entry no later than the Thursday prior to the show.

Important Details:

- PLEASE LEAVE ALL DOGS AT HOME
- **New Pick your test/Pick your time.** This option is ONLY available if you come to CARA and sign up on our bulletin board. You must pay at the time of sign up, if you do not, we do not hold your time. This option will be available from the opening date, 1 month prior until 2 weeks before show date. (We are working on an online option.)
- **For an entry to be on time, we must have payment before closing date. After the closing date, a late fee applies.**
- Tests will be pinned using the Danish system (Blue: 67% or higher, Red: 62%-66.999%, Yellow: 57%-61.999%, White: 52%-56.999%, Pink 47%-51.999%). This method rewards the rider's hard work and individual accomplishments without the stress of head-to-head competition.
- Results will be reported to USDF for the **USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program**. It is the Rider's responsibility to understand and comply with [USDF Rider Eligibility & Requirements](#) as well as submitting their score to USDF within 21 days of competition if they wish to be eligible for awards. Be sure to complete your [USDF Nomination Form](#).
- We may have to refuse an entry, and if we do, your entry fee will be refunded.
- Warmup will be in the outdoor arena adjacent to the competition covered arena. Both arenas have a composite footing of sand, and wood grindings.
- ASTM helmets are required at all times when mounted.
- Please follow USEF equipment rules. Illegal equipment including bandages etc. will not be allowed.
- Ride times will be posted the Thursday prior the show on our Facebook page [Central Arizona Riding Academy](#).
- We added Quadrille this year! Why? Because quadrille is really fun. You can ride one of the USDF tests or write your own. So get a team together and come show off!

- Fix A Test rides. If you would like to ride your test and then get 10 minutes input from the judge and re-ride your test please state so on your entry form or call 480-580-0634.

Financial Details:

- 1 entry for each horse and Rider combination
- Office fee (per horse & rider combination) \$10
- Class Fee \$30
- Schooling Only \$35
- Late fee \$10 per entry, applies if the entry and payment are not both received by the closing dates, and we can only take you if we have room,
- Full refunds will be given up to the show's closing date 7 days prior. Afterward no refunds.
- Fix A Test ride \$50.00
- Quadrille Entry \$15 per person (\$60 Total)
- Day stall (call if available) \$50

Excellence pins:

If your ride still rocks, but Miss MoneyBags shows up riding Mr. Olympic Retiree and blows the scores out of the water, your ride **still** deserves an award.

Certain movements really show off your horse's training. Any horse, regardless of talent, if correctly ridden, can get a high score on these movements. If you nail those movements and the judge gives you an 8 or higher, you will receive an excellence lapel pin. For every 8 on your test you receive another pin. Heck, by the end of the season, your show coat could be covered. The movements that will get you those incredible I-totally- rock-as -a- dressage rider pins are:

- Any rider score in the collectives
- All halts
- Turn on the haunches and walk pirouettes
- Free walk
- Stretchy trot circle
- Giving one or both reins in the canter
